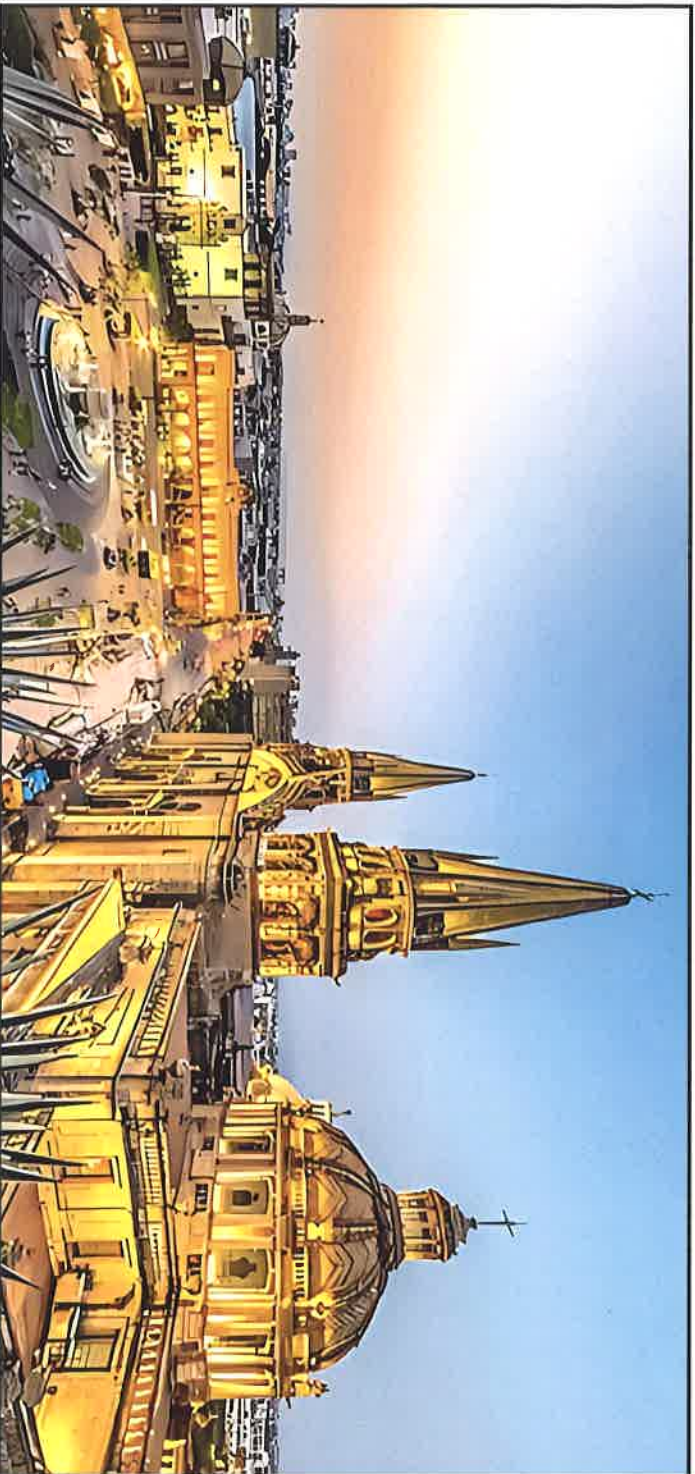

8 DAYS ITINERARY

DAY 1) ARRIVAL

Departing from Chicago and arriving in Mexico City. Upon arrival, we transfer to the **Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, one of the most sacred pilgrimage sites in the world. Here, we attend Mass and take in the spiritual significance of this holy place. Afterward, we head to our hotel for dinner and overnight rest.

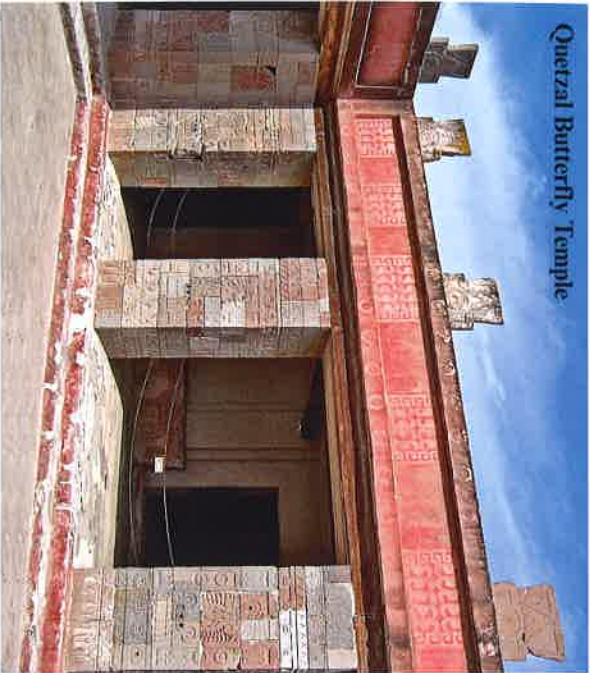

DAY 2) TEOTIHUACAN & SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we set off for Teotihuacan, the ancient Mesoamerican city known for its Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon. We explore the **Quetzal Butterfly Temple** and other significant ruins before having free time for lunch. Later, we return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for a guided tour of its sacred grounds. We then head back to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 4) DOWNTOWN & SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

This morning, after breakfast, we return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for a private Mass and time for personal prayers. Later, we explore the **historic downtown of Mexico City**, where we enjoy free time for lunch and sightseeing. In the afternoon, we take a guided tour of the area before heading back to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 3) COYOACÁN & XOCHIMILCO

After breakfast, we begin our day in the charming neighborhood of Coyoacán. Our first stop is the **Church of St. John the Baptist**, a stunning colonial-era church. We then enjoy a guided tour through Coyoacán's vibrant streets and plazas. Later, we transfer to Xochimilco, where we board a traditional **trajinera (gondola) ride** along the flower-filled canals. Free time for lunch. Our day concludes with Mass at **San Bernardino**, before returning to the hotel for dinner and rest.

DAY 5) SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE & GUANAJUATO

After breakfast, we leave Mexico City and head toward the beautiful colonial city of **San Miguel de Allende**. Here, we explore its picturesque streets and visit **La Parroquia de San Francisco**, where we attend Mass. In the afternoon, we continue our journey to **Guanajuato**, where we settle in for dinner and overnight.

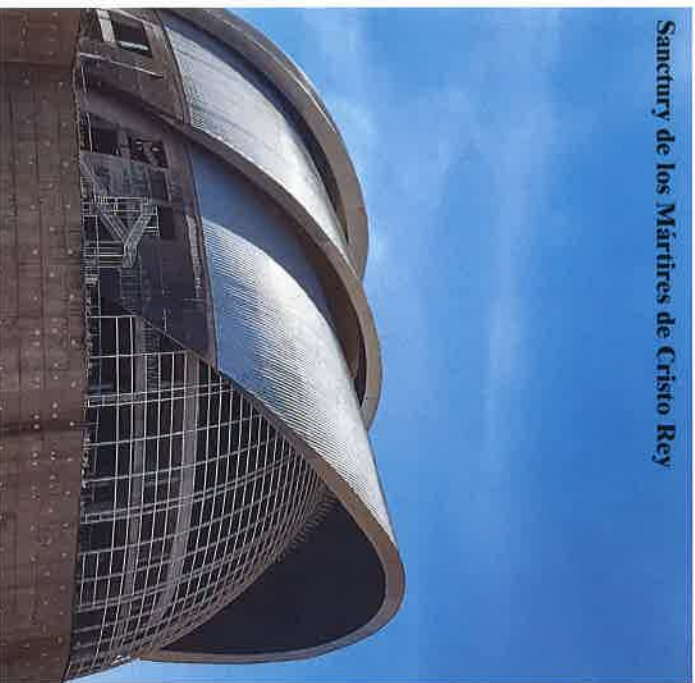

DAY 6) SAN JUAN DE LOS LAGOS & GUADALAJARA

Our journey continues to Tlaquepaque, where we visit the **Santuario de los Mártires de Cristo Rey**, a monument honoring the martyrs of the Cristero War. Finally, we transfer to our hotel in Guadalajara for dinner and overnight.

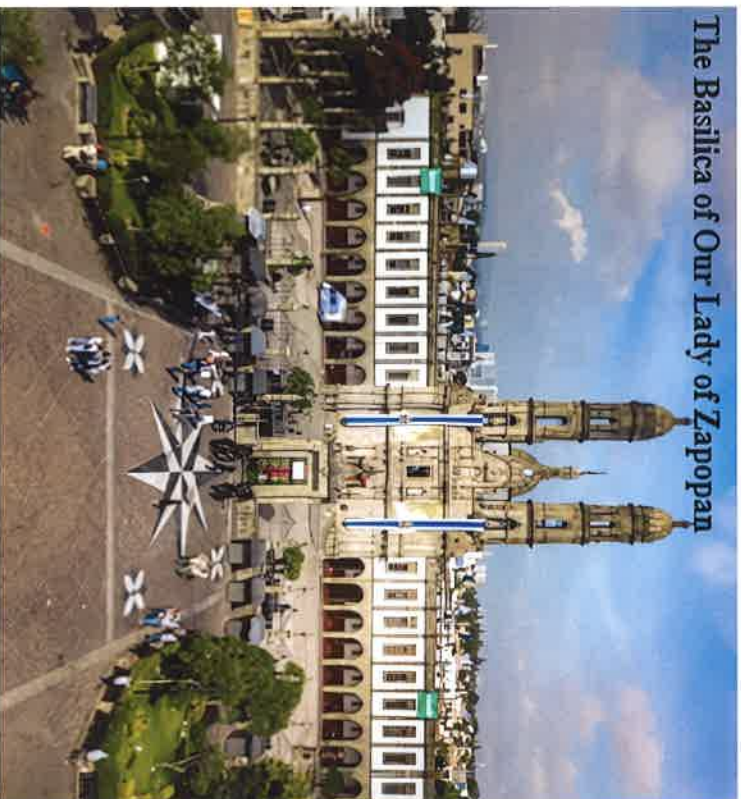

DAY 7) GUADALAJARA: CATHEDRAL & VIRGIN OF ZAPOPAN

This morning, after enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we set out on a guided walking tour through the heart of **Guadalajara's historic center**, a vibrant area filled with colonial architecture, lively plazas, and centuries of history. Our first stop is the **Cathedral of Guadalajara**, where we join in the celebration of Mass beneath its twin towers and impressive stained-glass windows. From there, we stroll through **Plaza de la Liberación**, a grand open square framed by monuments and

fountains, before continuing to the bustling **Mercado Libertad** (also known as **San Juan de Dios**), one of the largest indoor markets in Latin America. Here, travelers can marvel at the endless stalls offering local crafts, fresh foods, and regional specialties. We also pause at the elegant **Teatro Degollado**, an architectural jewel renowned for its neoclassical facade and exquisite interior. Following this morning's discoveries, there will be time to enjoy lunch on your own, with plenty of options nearby to taste Guadalajara's famed regional cuisine. In the afternoon, we drive to the neighboring city of **Zapopan**, an important spiritual destination in Jalisco. Here we visit the **Basilica of Our Lady of Zapopan**, home to the revered image of the Virgin of Zapopan, beloved throughout Mexico for her miraculous intercessions. The Basilica itself is an impressive sanctuary, featuring a richly decorated interior and an intricate marble altar that draws pilgrims year-round. After time for prayer and reflection, we return to Guadalajara, where our group gathers this evening for a festive farewell dinner—a chance to share memories, enjoy regional flavors, and celebrate the journey we have experienced together. Tonight, we enjoy our final overnight stay in Mexico, filled with gratitude for the rich culture, faith, and hospitality of this beautiful country.

DAY 8) DEPARTURE

After a memorable pilgrimage, we enjoy **breakfast at the hotel** before **transferring to the airport** for our return flights home, taking with us cherished memories and spiritual blessings.

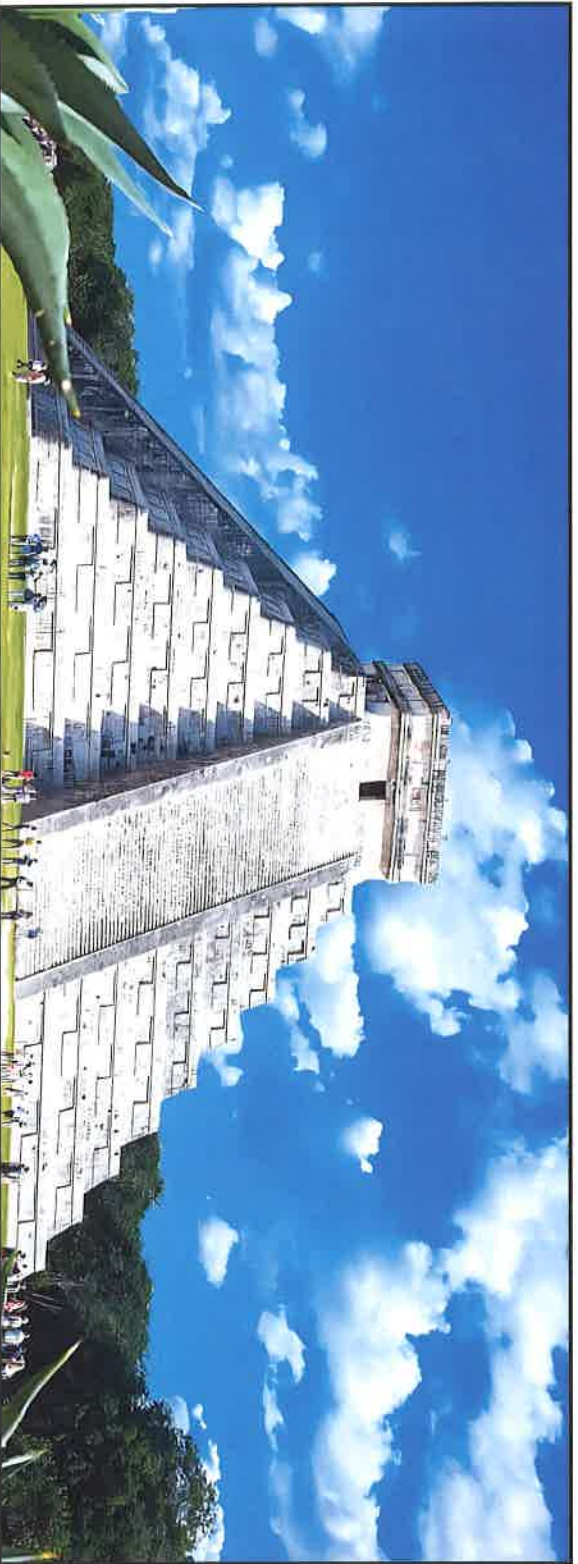
TO MEXICO

Deposit, Payment Schedule, and Registration A deposit of \$500.00 USD per person, which is non-refundable, is required at the time of reservation via a booking application. This deposit serves to cover services provided by Holy Pilgrim Tours, including, but not limited to, account management and administrative upkeep. The entirety of the payment is due 101 days prior to the scheduled departure. Should a reservation occur within 101 days of departure, full payment shall be required at the time of confirmation. Delays in payments or bookings may result in the forfeiture of specific services, including but not limited to access to certain sites or alternative flight arrangements. To be added to a waitlist, a \$500 deposit is required, which is fully refundable if confirmation cannot be secured within 14 days. All fees are stated in United States Dollars (USD) and are per person based on double occupancy. **For Our International Clients** Payments made in foreign currencies will be converted to their equivalent in United States Dollars (USD) according to the exchange rate on the date of payment. Clients assume the risk associated with any fluctuations in the exchange rate. **Accepted Forms of Payment** cash, checks, ACH transfers, American Express, Discover, Visa, and MasterCard. In the event of a billing error, we reserve the right to issue an amended invoice to correct the billing. **Price Guarantee** Prices are fixed and guaranteed once full payment for the trip has been received. While not anticipated, prices are subject to change due to significant external factors beyond our control. Holy Pilgrim Tours is not obliged to provide a detailed breakdown of costs and services included in the pilgrimage package. **Exclusions** The following are not included in the trip cost: Tips for guide and driver; travel, trip, and medical insurance; fees for passports and visas; personal items such as telephone calls, minibar charges, and laundry services; as well as drinks and meals unless explicitly mentioned. **Passports, Visas, and Travel Documents** All travelers are required to possess a valid passport, which must remain valid for at least six months beyond the date of their return. It is the sole responsibility of each traveler to secure and present necessary travel documents. Authorities in various countries may require possession of your passport under certain circumstances, such as at hotels or on cruise ships. It is mandatory upon passengers to procure any necessary visas or visa waivers. Holy Pilgrim Tours, its owners, agents, or employees shall not be held liable when clients fail to possess proper documentation/Valid Passport, visa, visa waiver, or any other needed travel documents.) Cancellations resulting from insufficient travel documents will incur standard penalties. Please be advised that a Passport Card is not valid for International Air Travel. **Final Documentation** Final documentation, including name tags, and travel itineraries, will be sent approximately two weeks prior to departure. Upon receipt, it is the traveler's responsibility to verify all details and to notify Holy Pilgrim Tours via email within 24 hours should there be any errors. It is important to ensure that communications from Holy Pilgrim Tours are not overlooked or redirected to your spam folder. To facilitate this, please add Holy Pilgrim Tours to your list of safe senders. To do so, open an email received from Holy Pilgrim Tours, navigate to the arrow near the email icon located at the far right of the email header, and select "Add To Contacts." A notification stating "Added Email Address to contacts" will appear, confirming that Holy Pilgrim Tours' emails will directly enter your inbox, protecting against any missed communications related to your pilgrimage. **Participation** Holy Pilgrim Tours and its contracted service providers reserve the right to refuse service or retain any individual whose behavior considered to disrupt tour operations or adversely affect the experience or safety of other passengers. In such cases, no liability for refund, compensation, repatriation, or any other claims shall be entertained by Holy Pilgrim Tours, its agents, or suppliers. **Cancellations and Refunds** All Cancellations are subject to penalties as follows: More than 101 days prior to departure: a penalty of \$500.00 USD per person. Between 61 and 100 days prior to departure: 35% of the total trip cost. Between 31 and 60 days prior to departure: 60% of the total trip cost. 30 days or fewer prior to departure: no refund is available. Cancellations must be submitted in writing from the email address registered for the tour and will become effective on the date received. Processing of refunds may require 30 to 60 days. **Further Cancellation Charges** Additional cancellation fees may be applicable under certain circumstances. Once airline tickets, including any upgrades, are issued, they are entirely non-refundable, though some exceptions may apply based on specific airline policies. Additional services booked in conjunction with the Holy Pilgrim Tours Pilgrimage, such as pre-post stays or other extra services, are subject to the same cancellation penalties unless otherwise specified. **Room Cancellation** In cases where a partial room cancellation occurs — if you cancel or depart from the pilgrimage early and a roommate remains — no refund will be available, and an additional surcharge may be imposed to cover the additional cost of the remaining occupancy. **Travel Insurance** We highly recommend a travel insurance plan to protect your trip investment. Verify with your insurance company the timeframe for purchasing coverage, especially for preexisting medical conditions, as it starts from the registration date with the initial deposit. Insurance is mostly available to all US residents. To File a Claim: Call your travel insurance company 24/7 Toll-free number that is usually given on your travel insurance documents. Mention your plan policy number located on your invoice. Travel Insurance is usually not available for purchase if you are very close to departure date, verify with your travel insurance company the due date for purchasing your intended coverage. **Assignment of Benefits** In the event of any trip interruption, such as an airline delay or cancellation, where Holy Pilgrim Tours has covered the cost of additional services subsequently reimbursed by the travel protection plan (e.g., airline, hotel, transfer), you agree to assign those payable benefits to Holy Pilgrim Tours, up to the total amount paid by Holy Pilgrim Tours. **Changes in Reservation** Once a reservation is confirmed, any modifications are subject to additional fees. Name changes are not allowed. **Flights / Airfares / Airline Reservations** By using Holy Pilgrim Tours, you acknowledge that Holy Pilgrim Tours acts solely as your agent when purchasing and arranging flights with air carriers, who operate as independent contractors. The airline ticket obtained through Holy Pilgrim Tours constitutes a contract between you and the airline. Holy Pilgrim Tours is not liable for, and does not assume any responsibility for, airline flight cancellations, schedule changes, delays, aircraft changes, seat map changes, seat assignments/reassignments, name changes, missed connections, claims for a refund or reimbursement of new airline ticket fees, missing days from the tour, or any other loss or expense incurred by you for any reason whatsoever. Should you be affected by flight changes on the day of departure or after departure, you agree to work directly with the airlines to rebook on the next available flight and arrange for your lodging and meals if necessary. We strongly recommend purchasing travel protection. Please save all receipts. Air transportation is provided in economy class or business class (additional cost) on IATA-approved carriers. We will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, we cannot guarantee it, as it is subject to the airline changing aircraft and the arrival time of the group for scheduled events. We recommend that you request this in writing on the Registration Form at the time you join the tour. **Business Class Upgrade:** Business Class is pending availability and seats are limited. If you book within 101 days prior to departure, additional costs may apply. **Seat Assignment:** Holy Pilgrim Tours will make every effort to request your desired seat. However, seat assignments cannot be guaranteed as airlines may change aircraft, resulting in seat map changes. Seat assignments are non-refundable. If you wish to change your seat assignment after it has been reserved and paid for, an additional fee will apply. We recommend arriving at the airport early to request your preferred seat assignment. On rare occasions, airlines do not offer seat assignments until you arrive at the airport for short flights. **Without Airfare / Land Only and Transfers:** If you choose to purchase your airfare independently, you can opt for the "Without Airfare" (or "Land Only") package. Airport transfers to/from hotels will be provided for the entire group together, not individually. Please provide us with your flight schedule via email up to 45 days prior to departure. We can arrange flights at an additional cost if necessary. Pilgrims' transfers to/from the airport are on a group basis. Should your flights arrive at a different airport than the group or outside of the group's arrival time, we can provide private transfers at the client's expense. In rare cases, a tour may be canceled, and any independently purchased airfares are the sole responsibility of the client. **Hotel Accommodations:** Hotel accommodations are based on twin-bedded or double rooms (double occupancy). Holy Pilgrim Tours reserves the right to substitute similar category hotels without prior notice. **Sharing Room:** Guests must provide the name of their travel roommate at the time of registration. **Triple Rooms:** Triple accommodations are possible in most hotels without a reduction in cost. Due to the pace of our pilgrimage, we do not recommend triple rooms, as it can be challenging to manage three suitcases and showers. Some hotels are not set up for triple rooms, and the third bed might be a sofa bed or a fold-up bed. **Room Upgrades & Requests:** Some hotels offer upgrades on request. Specific requests, such as adjacent or connecting rooms and bedding requests, will be accommodated if possible but cannot be guaranteed. **Private Rooms and Single Supplement:** Private rooms are available on a request basis, and guests are responsible for additional single supplement fees. Travelers without a roommate will be responsible for the single supplement. Note that some hotels' single rooms are smaller than standard rooms. **Hotel Check-In:** Most hotels allow check-ins during the mid-afternoon. If you wish to have a guaranteed room ready upon immediate check-in upon arrival, it can be arranged for an additional charge, usually the price of an additional night. are asked to advise us in writing at any time prior to departure and to identify themselves to their local tour guide at the beginning of the pilgrimage. **Baggage:** Each tour participant is permitted to bring one carry-on bag (8" x 14" x 22"), one personal item (e.g., purse, laptop case), and one checked bag weighing up to 50 lbs (23 kg) with maximum dimensions of 62 inches (158 cm) (length + width + height). Please check with your specific airline to verify the size and weight allowances. Holy Pilgrim Tours is not responsible for the loss, theft, delay, or damage to a participant's belongings. **Luggage Responsibility:** Holy Pilgrim Tours is not responsible if an airline loses your luggage, nor can we be responsible for the loss or damage of luggage and personal effects due to breakage, theft, or fair wear and tear through hotel, airline, and ground transportation handling. It is important to have adequate insurance to cover these eventualities. **Responsibility Clause:** Holy Pilgrim Tours acts as a tour operator. There are inherent risks in travel as our tours go sometimes through remote locations, far from medical facilities. Holy Pilgrim Tours pilgrims assume all associated risks and complete responsibility, including illness, injury, or even death by participating. You agree to indemnify and hold Holy Pilgrim Tours harmless from any claims made against Holy Pilgrim Tours by anyone else related to your participation. **Assigned Priest, Guest Speaker, Group Leader, or Tour Guide:** In the rare event that the assigned spiritual director, guest speaker, group leader, or tour guide can no longer attend, your reservation will remain unchanged, and you agree to travel as per our terms. **Special Medical Conditions:** Those Who Need Special Assistance must report any disability requiring special attention to Holy Pilgrim Tours at the time of registration. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance to any tour participant for walking, dining, while in their room, on flights, getting on and off motor coaches and other vehicles, or other personal needs. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany passengers who need special assistance. It is the Traveler's responsibility to arrange for such assistance prior to making their reservations. We will make an effort to accommodate disabled passengers by reserving wheelchair assistance at airports and handicap accessible rooms where available; however, we cannot guarantee and are not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.
