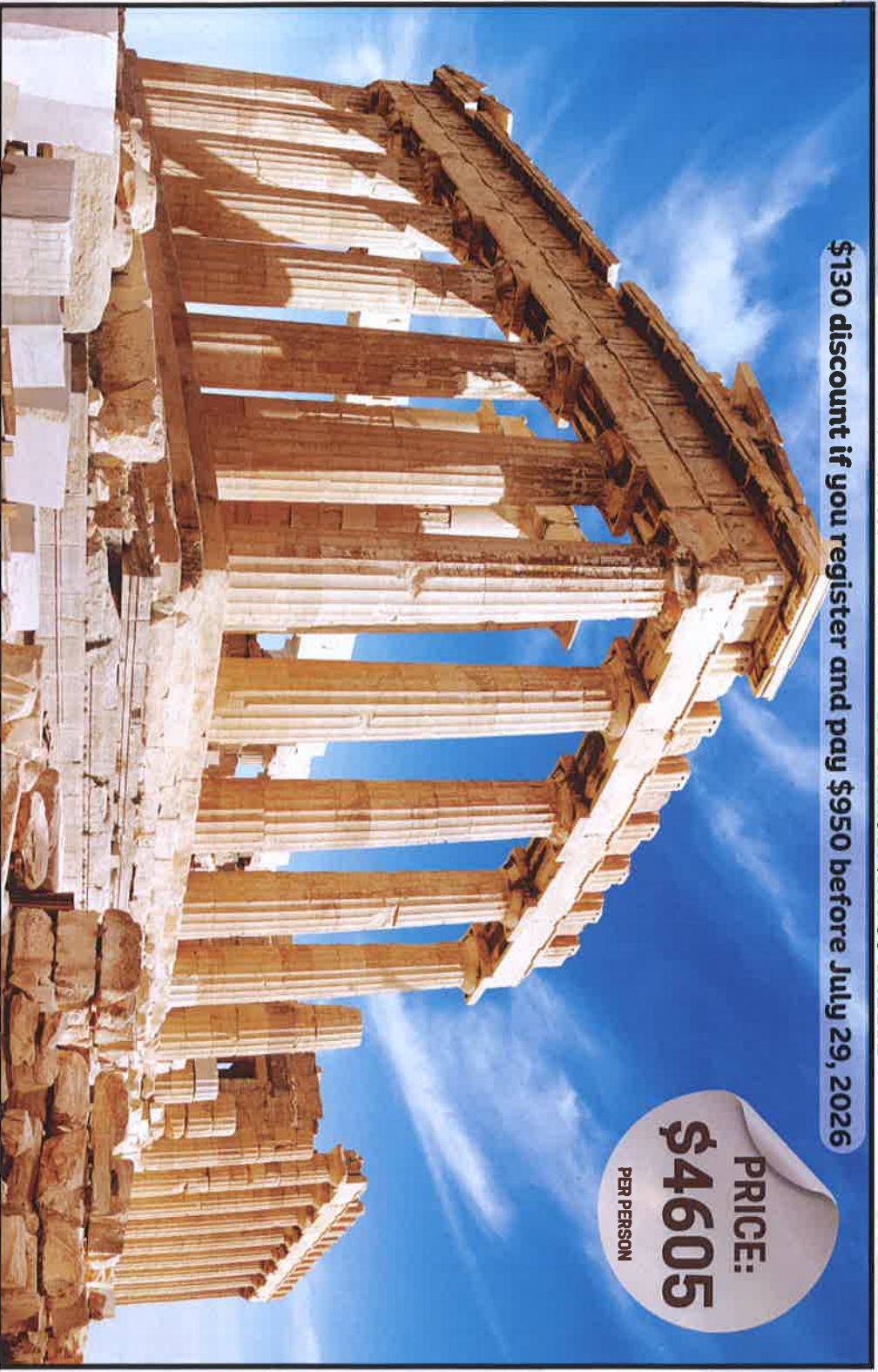

11 DAYS ITINERARY OF GREECE

DAY 1) Departure from Chicago & Overnight Flight
Overnight flight from Chicago to Thessaloniki.

DAY 2) ARRIVAL TO THESSALONIKI

Upon arrival at **Makedonia Thessaloniki Airport**, proceed to baggage claim and meet your guide or driver in the Arrivals Hall. Transfer by motorcoach to your hotel, where you'll check in and have time to rest.
Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 3) PHILIPPI - KAVALA - THESSALONIKI

After breakfast, begin your exploration in **Philippi**, where Saint Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe and established the continent's first Christian church. Visit the **site where Lydia was baptized**, the Roman Forum, and the ruins of the prison where Paul and Silas were held. Continue to **Kavala**, once known as **Neapolis**, the port where Paul, Silas, Luke, and Timothy first landed in Europe. Visit the **mosaic at St. Nicholas Church**, depicting Paul's Call to Macedonia, and see the ancient columns where Paul is believed to have tied his boat. Walk through a city that was later renamed **Christoupolis**, the first European city to accept Christianity. Explore the **Roman Aqueduct and the ruins of the Acropolis**.
Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 4) THESSALONIKI - KALAMBAKA

Following breakfast, drive to the awe-inspiring **Meteora Monasteries**, perched atop towering rock formations. Originally settled by monks in caves during the 11th century, these monasteries were later built high above the ground to protect against invasion. Admire the stunning Byzantine art, preserved architecture, and breathtaking landscapes that reflect centuries of monastic devotion. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 5) KALAMBAKA - METEORA - PATRAS

Following breakfast, depart **KALAMBAKA** for **Nafpactos**, a coastal town known for the **Battle of Lepanto and a memorial to Cervantes**, a Christian soldier and writer. Continue to **Patras**, **Greece's third-largest city**, located on the coast. Later on, we will celebrate private mass at **St. Andrew Catholic Church** in Patras. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 6) PATRAS - OLYMPIA - KALAMATA

Begin the day with a private Mass at **St. Andrew Catholic Church** in Patras. After Mass, drive through the beautiful Greek countryside to **Olympia**, birthplace of the Olympic Games. Visit the **ancient stadium**, **temples**, **training grounds**, and **sacred ruins** once visited by athletes and pilgrims from across the Greek world. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 7) KALAMATA - MESSENSE - MYSTRAS

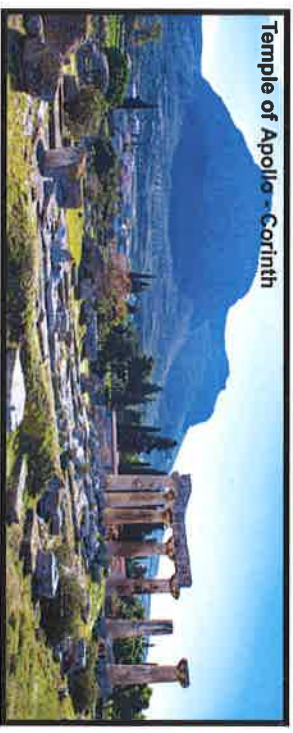
Start the day exploring **Mystras Archaeological Site**, visit the **Church of Agia Sophia and of St. Demetrios**, The **Monastery of Pantanassa**, and stunning views that reflects Greece Christian history. Later, **continue to Ancient Messene**, where you will walk through impressive ruins, including the **theater, stadium, temples, and city walls**. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 8) MYCENAE - ANCIENT CORINTH

Begin the day with a visit to **Mycenae Archaeological Site**, where you will see the famous **Lion Gate, ancient royal tombs, palace ruins**, and the impressive **Treasury of Atreus**. Later, continue to **Ancient Corinth**, a sacred biblical site where **St. Paul preached the Gospel for two years**. There, you will see the **ancient marketplace, the Temple of Apollo**. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 9) ATHENS

Begin your full-day tour of **Athens**, one of the world's oldest city. Visit the iconic **Acropolis**, including the **Parthenon, Erechtheum, and Propylene**. Climb **Mars Hill**, where **St. Paul preached to the Athenians** about the one true God. Explore the **Ancient Agora**, once the center of civic life, then drive by **Syntagma Square**, the **Greek Parliament**, the University of Athens, and the National Library. Visit the **Panathenaic Stadium**, site of the first modern Olympics, and conclude with a visit to the **New Acropolis Museum**, built over Byzantine ruins and home to artifacts from Greece's Bronze Age to the early Christian era. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 10) Byzantine and Christian Museum - Cape Sounion

Today, explore the **Byzantine and Christian Museum**, which preserves over 25,000 religious artifacts from the 3rd to 20th century, chronicling the development of Christian art and devotion. In the afternoon, drive along the scenic coastal road to **Cape Sounion**. End route, see the location where Paul's ship docked when arriving in Athens. End your day with a visit to the **Temple of Poseidon**, overlooking the Aegean Sea. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

After **breakfast**, you will transfer to the airport for your return flight. As you head home, you will carry with you beautiful memories and a renewed sense of faith and lasting memories inspired by the footsteps of the Apostles.

Terms and Conditions

Deposit, Payment Schedule, and Registration A deposit of \$500.00 USD per person, which is non-refundable, is required at the time of reservation via a booking application. This deposit serves to cover services provided by Holy Pilgrim Tours, including, but not limited to, account management and administrative upkeep. The entirety of the payment is due 101 days prior to the scheduled departure. Should a reservation occur within 101 days of departure, full payment shall be required at the time of confirmation. Delays in payments or bookings may result in the forfeiture of specific services, including but not limited to access to certain sites or alternative flight arrangements. To be added to a waitlist, a \$500 deposit is required, which is fully refundable if confirmation cannot be secured within 14 days. All fees are stated in United States Dollars (USD) and are per person based on double occupancy. **For Our International Clients** Payments made in foreign currencies will be converted to their equivalent in United States Dollars (USD) according to the exchange rate on the date of payment. Clients assume the risk associated with any fluctuations in the exchange rate. **Accepted Forms of Payment** cash, checks, ACH transfers, American Express, Discover, Visa, and MasterCard. In the event of a billing error, we reserve the right to issue an amended invoice to correct the billing. **Price Guarantee** Prices are fixed and guaranteed once full payment for the trip has been received. While not anticipated, prices are subject to change due to significant external factors beyond our control, including but not limited to major fluctuations in currency exchange rates. In the event of a substantial and unforeseen currency exchange fluctuation that materially impacts the cost of the pilgrimage package (**defined as a global currency exchange rate loss of more than two percent (2%) against the U.S. Dollar**), the package price will be adjusted accordingly to cover such increased costs. Holy Pilgrim Tours is not obliged to provide a detailed breakdown of costs and services included in the pilgrimage package. **Exclusions** The following are not included in the trip cost: Tips for guide and driver; travel, trip, and medical insurance; fees for passports and visas; personal items such as telephone calls, minibar charges, and laundry services; as well as drinks and meals unless explicitly mentioned. **Passports, Visas, and Travel Documents** All travelers are required to possess a valid passport, which must remain valid for at least six months beyond the date of their return. It is the sole responsibility of each traveler to secure and present necessary travel documents. Authorities in various countries may require possession of your passport under certain circumstances, such as at hotels or on cruise ships. It is mandatory upon passengers to procure any necessary visas or visa waivers. Holy Pilgrim Tours, its owners, agents, or employees shall not be held liable when clients fail to possess proper documentation (Valid Passport, visa, visa waiver, or any other needed travel documents.) Cancellations resulting from insufficient travel documents will incur standard penalties. Please be advised that a Passport Card is not valid for International Air Travel. **Final Documentation** Final documentation, including name tags, and travel itineraries, will be sent approximately two weeks prior to departure. Upon receipt, it is the traveler's responsibility to verify all details and to notify Holy Pilgrim Tours via email within 24 hours should there be any errors. It is important to ensure that communications from Holy Pilgrim Tours are not overlooked or redirected to your spam folder. To facilitate this, please add Holy Pilgrim Tours to your list of safe senders. To do so, open an email received from Holy Pilgrim Tours, navigate to the arrow near the email icon located at the far right of the email header, and select "Add To Contacts." A notification stating "Added Email Address to contacts" will appear, confirming that Holy Pilgrim Tours' emails will directly enter your inbox, protecting against any missed communications related to your pilgrimage. **Participation** Holy Pilgrim Tours and its contracted service providers reserve the right to refuse service or retain any individual whose behavior considered to disrupt tour operations or adversely affect the experience or safety of other passengers. In such cases, no liability for refund, compensation, repatriation, or any other claims shall be entertained by Holy Pilgrim Tours, its agents, or suppliers. **Cancellations and Refunds** All Cancellations are subject to penalties as follows: More than 101 days prior to departure: a penalty of \$500.00 USD per person. Between 61 and 100 days prior to departure: 35% of the total trip cost. Between 31 and 60 days prior to departure: 60% of the total trip cost. 30 days or fewer prior to departure: no refund is available. Cancellations must be submitted in writing from the email address registered for the tour and will become effective on the date received. Processing of refunds may require 30 to 60 days. **Further Cancellation Charges** Additional cancellation fees may be applicable under certain circumstances. Once airline tickets, including any upgrades, are issued, they are entirely non-refundable, though some exceptions may apply based on specific airline policies. Additional services booked in conjunction with the Holy Pilgrim Tours Pilgrimage, such as pre-post stays or other extra services, are subject to the same cancellation penalties unless otherwise specified. **Room Cancellation** In cases where a partial room cancellation occurs — if you cancel or depart from the pilgrimage early and a roommate remains — no refund will be available, and an additional surcharge may be imposed to cover the additional cost of the remaining occupancy. **Travel Insurance** We highly recommend a travel insurance plan to protect your trip investment. Verify with your insurance company the timeframe for purchasing coverage, especially for preexisting medical conditions, as it starts from the registration date with the initial deposit. Insurance is mostly available to all US residents. To File a Claim: Call your travel insurance company 24/7 Toll-free number that is usually given on your travel insurance documents. Mention your plan policy number located on your invoice. Travel Insurance is usually not available for purchase if you are very close to departure date, verify with your travel insurance company the due date for purchasing your intended coverage. **Assignment of Benefits** In the event of any trip interruption, such as an airline delay or cancellation, where Holy Pilgrim Tours has covered the cost of additional services subsequently reimbursed by the travel protection plan (e.g., airline, hotel, transfer), you agree to assign those payable benefits to Holy Pilgrim Tours, up to the total amount paid by Holy Pilgrim Tours. **Changes in Reservation** Once a reservation is confirmed, any modifications are subject to additional fees. Name changes are not allowed. **Flights / Airfares / Airline Reservations** By using Holy Pilgrim Tours, you acknowledge that Holy Pilgrim Tours acts solely as your agent when purchasing and arranging flights with air carriers, who operate as independent contractors. The airline ticket obtained through Holy Pilgrim Tours constitutes a contract between you and the airline. Holy Pilgrim Tours is not liable for, and does not assume any responsibility for, airline flight cancellations, schedule changes, delays, aircraft changes, seat map changes, seat assignments/reassignments, name changes, missed connections, claims for a refund or reimbursement of new airline ticket fees, missing days from the tour, or any other loss or expense incurred by you for any reason whatsoever. Should you be affected by flight changes on the day of departure or after departure, you agree to work directly with the airlines to rebook on the next available flight and arrange for your lodging and meals if necessary. We strongly recommend purchasing travel protection. Please save all receipts. Air transportation is provided in economy class or business class (additional cost) on IATA-approved carriers. Business-class upgrades are available at an additional cost and subject to availability. If you make changes, airfare is subject to change. Any issues related to airline service complaints and compensation should be addressed directly to the specific carrier. Airport taxes are included in our tour packages and are based on the departure city and government fees (including Federal Inspection Fees for U.S. Customs and Immigration, International Air Transportation Tax, Agricultural tax, security fees, and other airport-related taxes). If you have a preference for a specific airline, please advise us at the time of booking under Special Notes in the Registration Form. We will make every effort to accommodate your request; however, we cannot guarantee it, as it is subject to the airline changing aircraft and the arrival time of the group for scheduled events. We recommend that you request this in writing on the Registration Form at the time you join the tour. **Business Class Upgrade:** Business Class is pending availability and seats are limited. If you book within 101 days prior to departure, additional costs may apply. **Seat Assignment:** Holy Pilgrim Tours will make every effort to request your desired seat. However, seat assignments cannot be guaranteed as airlines may change aircraft, resulting in seat map changes. Seat assignments are non-refundable. If you wish to change your seat assignment after it has been reserved and paid for, an additional fee will apply. We recommend arriving at the airport early to request your preferred seat assignment. On rare occasions, airlines do not offer seat assignments until you arrive at the airport for short flights. **Without Airfare / Land Only and Transfers:** If you choose to purchase your airfare independently, you can opt for the "Without Airfare" (or "Land Only") package. Airport transfers to/from hotels will be provided for the entire group together, not individually. Please provide us with your flight schedule via email up to 45 days prior to departure. We can arrange flights at an additional cost if necessary. Pilgrims' transfers to/from the airport are on a group basis. Should your flights arrive at a different airport than the group or outside of the group's arrival time, we can provide private transfers at the client's expense. In rare cases, a tour may be canceled, and any independently purchased airfares are the sole responsibility of the client. **Hotel Accommodations:** Hotel accommodations are based on twin-bedded or double rooms (double occupancy). Holy Pilgrim Tours reserves the right to substitute similar category hotels without prior notice. **Sharing Room:** Guests must provide the name of their travel roommate at the time of registration. **Triple Rooms:** Triple accommodations are possible in most hotels without a reduction in cost. Due to the pace of our pilgrimage, we do not recommend triple rooms, as it can be challenging to manage three suitcases and showers. Some hotels are not set up for triple rooms, and the third bed might be a sofa bed or a fold-up bed. **Room Upgrades & Requests:** Some hotels offer upgrades on request. Specific requests, such as adjacent or connecting rooms and bedding requests, will be accommodated if possible but cannot be guaranteed. **Private Rooms and Single Supplement:** Private rooms are available on a request basis, and guests are responsible for additional single supplement fees. Travelers without a roommate will be responsible for the single supplement. Note that some hotels' single rooms are smaller than standard rooms. **Hotel Check-In:** Most hotels allow check-ins during the midafternoon. If you wish to have a guaranteed room ready upon immediate check-in upon arrival, it can be arranged for an additional charge, usually the price of an additional night. If your flight arrives early in the morning and your room is not ready, you may leave your luggage with hotel staff while you explore. **Meals:** We try to accommodate special meal requests by forwarding them to the restaurants we work with.
