CHICAGO/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9

Enjoy a full day excursion along the Istrian Riviera coastline to Pula, a strategic port since the times of the ancient Romans. Visit the Roman amphitheater, one of the largest remaining in existence, built on a site overlooking the seacoast. Continue to the resort of Rovinj, a coastal town built on land that was once an island but is now connected to the mainland by a causeway. Visit the baroque Cathedral of St. Eufemija before returning to Opatija and your hotel for overnight. **(B,D)**

OPATIJA/ZADAR/SPLIT THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12

This morning drive south along the seacoast to Zadar, the oldest Slavic city on the Adriatic and a once famed cultural center. Take a walking tour of the city which includes a visit to St. Donat Church. Continue on to the coastal city of Split located in the Croatian province of Dalmatia. (B)

SPLIT/DUBROVNIK

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13

Your morning sightseeing tour of Split provides a look at the city's Roman heritage as well as its Renaissance and Gothic structures. Visit the ancient Roman Palace of Diocletian, considered to be the greatest Roman ruin in Central Europe built in 305 AD. As you stand in the peristyle (central court) of this grand structure, its scale is sure to impress you. Then depart for Dubrovnik passing old fishing villages and new resorts as you drive along the spectacular Dalmatian seacoast. **(B)**

DUBROVNIK/MEDJUGORJE SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 14

One of the most recognizable features of Dubrovnik that give the city its character are the intact walls, which encircle the city. This beautiful complex structure is renowned throughout Europe and a main attraction for its visitors. Your tour this morning will include visits to the Dominican Monastery with its art collection from the 15th and 16th centuries and the Rector's Palace. In the afternoon drive across the border into Bosnia Herze-





govina to the village of Medjugorje, where 6 teenagers encountered the Blessed Virgin Mary on a hillside near the village. (B,D)

MEDJUGORJE

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15

Today you will spend time in prayer and meditation on Apparition Hill where the young visionaries first encountered Our Lady. (B,D)

MEDJUGORJE/PLITVICE LAKES MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16

This morning drive further inland towards the beautiful UNESCO Heritage Plitvice Lakes National Park. Each of the lakes in the park is at a different elevation and feeds into the next through a series of spectacular cascades and waterfalls. (B,D)

PLITVICE LAKES/BLED

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17

Enjoy the breathtaking scenery of Plitvice Lakes National Park. The thickly wooded mountains and lush vegetation surround the 16 sparkling, terraced lakes. Enjoy a walk in the park and take a boat ride around one of the lakes. This afternoon depart for Slovenia and the resort town of Bled, beautifully situated on Lake Bled in the Julian Alps. (B)

BLED/LJUBLJANA/BLED

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18

Today drive to Ljubljana, Slovenia's capital city. Much of Ljubljana was rebuilt after a devastating earthquake

in 1895, however there are a number of older buildings that survived and still stand in historic part of town. Your city tour will include a visit to the Franciscan Church. See Ljubljana Castle, the famous 'Three Bridges' and



the Dragon Bridge near the Cathedral of St. Nicholas. After your tour, return to Bled where the balance of the day is at leisure. (B,D)

Say goodbye to Slovenia as your depart today and drive across the border to Italy. Continue on to Venice and your hotel for overnight. (B)
