On top of the visit to Our Lady of the Almudena at the heart of Madrid, we will have a chance to enjoy cultural elements like a visit to the Prado Museum, seeing the unique architectures with Christian, Jewish and Moorish influences. Perhaps we can arrange a chance to see flamenco dancing and have some jamon iberica and paella, at our own leisure.

From Spain, we drive to the spiritually charged shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes by the foothills of the Pyrennes Mountains in Southwestern France. Here we will have many opportunities to connect with the deepest traditions of prayer and get to know the story of the Apparition of the Virgin Mary to the shepherd girl Bernadette Soubirous. As we get to the final leg of the journey, we will continue with another important visit to the Benedictine Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat as we head to Barcelona, the center of Spanish culture and arts, where we feast our eyes in beauty and our tongues in delicious Spanish cuisine.

This pilgrimage is truly one of my favorites, not only because of my love for the Blessed Virgin Mary, but also because of the many incredible cultural experiences that it can offer.

I therefore encourage you to reserve your spot quickly by sending me a completed form together with a \$500.00 deposit as soon as possible. This pilgrimage gets full very fast, based on previous experience. Places will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. ## CHICAGO/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

Depart this evening from Chicago on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight to Portugal.

#### **ARRIVE LISBON**

#### **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1**

Arrive today in the capital city of Lisbon. In the 15th Century, Portugal was the first nation to begin exploration and trade far from the shores of the Mediterranean. Upon arrival in Lisbon, transfer to your hotel. (D)

#### LISBON/FATIMA WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 2

After breakfast enjoy a brief orientation tour of Lisbon before departing for the village of Fatima, the

world's most famous Marian shrine. Here, on the thirteenth of each month between May and October in 1917, the Blessed Mother appeared to three young children and exhorted the world to pray for world peace. Your visit this afternoon will include the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima, site of Francisco and Jacinta's graves, and the Little Chapel of Appari-



tions with the statue of "Our Lady of Fatima." Time for devotion and worship. (B,D)

## FATIMA/COIMBRA/SALAMANCA THURSDAY, OCTOBER 3

This morning head to Coimbra, site of the Monastery of St Clare. On to Salamanca, Spain's famed old university town. The city dates back to before the Roman era and its diverse history has deeply influenced the culture and architecture making it one of Spain's most fascinating cities. Upon arrival, enjoy an orientation tour. Overnight in Salamanca. (B,D)



### SALAMANCA/AVILA/MADRID FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4

Visit Alba de Tormes, one of the most important pilgrimage centers in Spain. See the Carmelite Convent where the preserved body of St Theresa lies. Continue to the walled city of Avila, the birthplace and home of St. Teresa, the founder of the Order of the Carmelites. Visit the Monastery of the Incarnation, where Teresa entered Carmel, made her Solemn Profession, and lived for the next 25 years. Also, visit the foundation of the reform, St. Joseph Monastery. See the beautiful Plaza de Santa Teresa and other sites connected with her life. Cross the rugged Sierra de Guadarrama on the way to Madrid, the capital city of Spain. (B)

#### **MADRID**

#### **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5**

This morning you will see the white-trimmed 2,800 -room Royal Palace and the exquisite gardens that surround it, the Puerta del Sol, Cervantes Memorial, the Plaza de Espana, the acacia-lined Castellana, and the Avenida Jose Antonio. Then visit the Prado Museum, housing a collection of masterpieces by Spain's artists Velazquez, Goya and El Greco. Your afternoon is at leisure for shopping or exploring on your own.

#### MADRID/LOURDES

#### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6**

Today you head northeast through the quaint scenery of the mountainous Spanish countryside. Then cross the border into France to the shrine city of Lourdes where between February 11th and July 16th, 1858, the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times. Scratching the ground as instructed by Mary, Bernadette saw a miraculous spring well up where none had existed before.

#### **MONDAY, OCTOBER 7**

This morning you visit the Grotto of Apparitions, Rosary Basilica, Basilica of St. Pius X and Way of the Cross over the Hillside. This afternoon is at leisure



for personal reflection and devotion. Attend the Blessed Sacrament Procession and the Torchlight Procession, if taking place. (B,D)

## LOURDES/MONTSERRAT/BARCELONA TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8

This morning depart Lourdes and head to Barcelona, considered to be the cultural center of Spain. On the way stop at the dramatically set 12<sup>th</sup> century Benedictine Archabbey of Montserrat. Perched high on sheer rock rising abruptly from the Catalonian plain, it is the spiritual heart of Catalonia. Pilgrims have been visiting Montserrat for over 700 years. Visit the royal Basilica where you will see the venerated 6<sup>th</sup> century statue of the Black Madonna, Our Lady of Montserrat. After your visit continue to Barcelona and your hotel for the night.

#### **BARCELONA**

#### WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9

Barcelona is the cultural and political center of Catalonia and Spain's most European city. The city itself is divided into two major parts: the older area symbolized by the Gothic Quarter and the more modern part with its wide avenues. This morning enjoy a city tour including a visit to the Gothic Quarter. See the Gothic palaces of the Government of Catalonia and the City Hall, the world-famous Cathedral with its fine medieval cloister and arcades, and view from the outside, the towering La Sagrada Familia Church designed by the Catalonian architect Antoni Gaudí. Begun in 1882, the church is still under construction today. The afternoon is at leisure to further explore this magnificent city on your own. You may wish to do more sightseeing, shopping or perhaps take time to relax and try some tapas at a sidewalk café. **(B)**
